New Hampshire's first and largest makerspace, MakeIt Labs, is hosting their premiere event, MakeIt Fest, on Saturday, June 8th, 2019. It will be held at MakeIt Labs, 25 Crown St, Nashua NH, from 12:00 to 5:00 pm. Admission is free.

MakeIt Fest is an outdoor fair where local makers, artists, craftsmen, and makerspaces gather to show things they have made. Several area makerspaces will be present, so it's a great opportunity to discover what makerspaces are, and what they have to offer. There will be a raffle of items, including a 3D printer, and also items for sale.

At MakeIt Fest there will be exhibitions and demonstrations, including creation of ice cream using liquid nitrogen. Scheduled activities include classes and tours throughout the day, and a Sumo Robot contest, where miniature robots compete in a ring. R2D2 will be meeting and greeting the attendees. Early-bird tickets on makeitfest.com include a complimentary raffle ticket.

A makerspace is a community work space that provides access to tools, classes, and opportunities for collaboration. Makerspaces provide a variety of equipment and tools for making things, including 3D printers, laser cutters, CNC machines, soldering irons, computers, video and audio equipment, woodworking equipment, machining and metal-working equipment, sewing machines, and fine arts equipment like pottery wheels. The most important part of a makerspace is the community of people who are willing and eager to share their expertise.
